In order to take the driving test you **MUST** report to the Driver's Service Facility with a parent or legal guardian or a licensed driver over the age of 21 with an Affidavit for Minor to Drive signed by a parent and notarized and

"ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:"

- 1) County Certified Birth Certificate or a Valid Passport or Resident Card
- 2) Social Security Card **(NO Faxes, Copies or Printouts)**
- 3) Verification of Address (2 pieces of mail in your name, if you are a minor 1 piece of mail and a parent's Illinois Drivers License or Illinois State ID)
- 4) Instruction Permit / Receipt
- 5) The 50 Hour Certification of Driving (Completed and Signed)
- 6) A Vehicle in Good Working Condition
- 7) Insurance Card- Current and make sure it's for the vehicle you are testing in
